It requires the Governor, rather than the chair of the committee, to appoint 4 of the 25 members of the committee. 26 2. It requires the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over 27 criminal justice and public safety matters to review, and the Legislature to confirm, the 28 appointments made by the Governor to the committee. 29 3. It requires an academic with a doctorate in biological sciences, rather than an 30 academic research scientist, to be appointed to the committee. 31 4. It requires the committee to make recommendations for each laboratory in the bill 32 to the entity that has specific oversight authority over the laboratory. 33 5.
