The bill provides that when an answer is entered or 20 the court declines to accept an answer admitting or not contesting the allegations of a 21 petition, an adjudicatory hearing must be set. This amendment removes the reference to 22 an adjudicatory hearing and instead provides that the matter must be set for further 23 proceedings in order to accommodate existing local procedures.
