Fiscal Detail and Notes

Dedicating 50% of the 5% sales tax revenue collected from consumer fireworks sales to the Maine Length of Service Award Program Trust Fund requires a General Fund transfer of \$190,000 in FY 2014-15 and \$198,170 in FY 2015-16 and a transfer from Municipal Revenue Sharing of \$10,000 in FY 2014-15 and \$10,430 in FY 2015-16. This bill includes an Other Special Revenue Funds allocation of \$190,000 in fiscal year 2014-15. Committee Amendment "A" to LD 1509, the 2014-2015 budget, includes a provision that temporarily increases the sales tax to 5.5%. This estimate of fiscal impact may need to be revisited after final legislative action on the budget.
