Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the transfer which reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$217,987 in fiscal year 2014-15. It reduces the Other Special Revenue Funds allocation from \$229,460 to \$500 in fiscal year 2014-15.
