4 5 6 7	L. In the adoption and amendment of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code, adopt the standards for residential basement wall insulation under the 2006 edition of the International Energy Conservation Code, as amended and published by the International Code Council; and
8	SUMMARY
9	Current law requires the Department of Public Safety, Office of the State Fire
10	Marshal, Technical Building Codes and Standards Board to adopt, maintain and amend
11	the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code, using building codes published by the
12	International Code Council or Building Officials and Code Administrators International,
13	Inc., or the Maine Model Building Code or the International Existing Building Code.
14	This bill requires the board to use the most up-to-date version of the International Energy Conservation Code in adopting standards for residential basement wall insulation.
