Amend the amendment in section 1 in §10121-A in the first line (page 1, line 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Renewable Energy Rebate Program Fund" and inserting in its place the following: 'Cost-effective Low-income Energy Fund'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §10121-A by striking out all of subsection 1 (page 1, lines 17 to 23 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'1. Fund established. There is established the Cost-effective Low-income Energy Fund, referred to in this section as "the fund," to be used by the trust solely for the purposes of providing rebates for cost-effective electric technologies, including solar photovoltaic and solar thermal technologies, heat pumps and other technologies that may be used to reduce energy costs and greenhouse gas emissions, as determined by the trust. The trust may provide rebates only to those persons eligible to participate in the Lowincome Home Energy Assistance Program administered through the United States Department of Health and Human Services. Any interest on funds in the fund must be credited to the fund. Funds not spent in any fiscal year remain in the fund to be used for the purposes of this subsection.'

Amend the amendment in section 1 in §10121-A in subsection 3 in paragraph A (page 2, lines 5 and 6 in amendment) by striking out the following: "a solar photovoltaic or solar thermal technology" and inserting the following: 'solar photovoltaic and solar thermal technologies, heat pumps or other technologies'

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The committee amendment created the Renewable Energy Rebate Fund. This amendment changes the name to the Cost-effective Low-income Energy Fund and the allocations and transfers in the committee amendment are moved to the new fund. This amendment limits the eligibility for the rebates to people who participate in the Low-income Home Energy Assistance Program, which may reduce the number of rebates given.
