4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5 6	This bill proposes to provide municipalities with the ability to form districts for the purpose of coordinating transit services, such as bike paths, pedestrian paths, bus routes
7 8	and rail routes, in individual municipalities and in coordination with other municipalities along defined transportation corridors.
