Implementation of multiple pathways and opportunities. Students may 18 demonstrate achievement of the standards through multiple pathways as set out under 19 section 4703 and multiple opportunities. Achievement may be demonstrated by evidence 20 documented by course and learning experiences using multiple measures, such as, but not 21 limited to, examinations, quizzes, portfolios, performances, exhibitions and, projects and 22 community service. 23 Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §4722-A, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 2011, c. 669, §7, is 24 amended to read: 25 2. Method of gaining and demonstrating proficiency. Students must be allowed 26 to gain proficiency through multiple pathways, as described in section 4703, and must be 27 allowed to demonstrate proficiency by presenting multiple types of evidence, including 28 but not limited to teacher-designed or student-designed assessments, portfolios, 29 performance, exhibitions and, projects and community service.' 30 SUMMARY 31 This amendment replaces the bill. Current law provides that high school students 32 must be allowed to demonstrate achievement of diploma standards by presenting multiple 33 types of evidence. This amendment adds community service to the multiple types of 34 evidence.
