SENATE AMENDMENT " A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 472, L.D. 1353, Bill, "An Act To Further Reduce Student Hunger"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title and before the first paragraph the following:
'Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least $90 \%$ of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, $2 / 3$ of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.' '
