Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 7th line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by
striking out the following: "video"

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report for the Joint Standing Committee on
Education and Cultural Affairs, amends the bill to remove videos of students from the
images from which a student can be identified that a public school is restricted from
publishing on the Internet without first obtaining written parental consent to provide the
image.
