1 2	Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and		
3 4 5	Whereas, legislation enacted in the First Regular Session of the 126th Legislature again restricted the eligibility of employees in the executive, judicial and legislative branches of government to receive merit pay increases and longevity pay; and		
6 7	Whereas, this legislation needs to take effect before the end of the 2013-14 fiscal year in order to provide eligible employees with earned benefits; and		
8 9 10 11	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

It includes General Fund appropriations and Highway Fund 32 allocations to offset reductions made in the biennial budgets for 2014-2015 to restore 33

funding for merit increases and longevity payments.

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
