24 SUMMARY

This amendment changes the title of the bill and, in addition to the funding provided to the Maine Criminal Justice Academy in the bill, provides funding to:

- 1. The Department of Economic and Community Development to support the code enforcement officer training and certification program;
- 2. The Maine Lakes Society to manage and analyze certain data to assist with water pollution control, water quality protection and other environmental training programs;
 - 3. The Department of Education for HIV prevention training and education;
- 4. The Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Revenue Services for 3 positions to allow the bureau to address tax collection cases; and
- 5. The Department of Corrections for 3 months of contracted clinical staff to a mental health unit at the Maine State Prison.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill reduces the General Fund cost of the bill by \$250,000 in fiscal year 2014-15, which is equal to the appropriations in the original bill.

The amendment adds an ongoing General Fund appropriation of \$71,500 beginning in fiscal year 2014-15 to support the Maine Lakes Society, to manage and analyze certain data and for development and implementation of water pollution control, water quality protection and other environmental training programs.

This amendment includes ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$30,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2014-15 to the Community Development Block Grant program within the Department of Economic and Community Development to support the code enforcement officer training and certification program.

This amendment also includes ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$150,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2014-15 to the Maine HIV Prevention Education Program within the Department of Education for HIV prevention training and education.

It includes a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services of \$227,459 for one Senior Tax Examiner position and 2 Tax Examiner positions in order to increase Maine Revenue Services' levy capability and address an extensive inventory of collection cases. This activity is expected to increase General Fund and Local Government Fund revenues by \$1,140,000 and \$60,000, respectively, in fiscal year 2014-15.
