| 13 14 15 | A. Customers of a consumer-owned water utility may petition the commission to rescind an exemption granted under this section to an individual consumer-owned water utility or to a class of consumer-owned water utilities; and |
| 16 17 18 | B. The commission may on its own motion rescind an exemption granted under this section to an individual consumer-owned water utility or to a class of consumer-owned water utilities. |
| 19 20 | A rescission may be in whole or in part and may be specific to an individual consumer- owned water utility.' |
| 21 | SUMMARY |
| 22 | This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A." The amendment authorizes |
| 23 | the Public Utilities Commission to rescind an exemption on its own motion. |

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The amendment explicitly allows the Public Utilities Commission (PUC), on its own motion without a petition, to rescind an exemption to an individual consumer-owned water utility or a class of consumer-owned water utilities from certain regulations under Title 35-A. Any additional costs to the PUC are expected to be minor and can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
