8 9	SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1320, L.D. 1831, Bill, "An Act To Allow Signs for Areas of Local, Regional and Statewide Interest on the Interstate System"
10	Amend the bill in section 3 in §1912-C by inserting after subsection 5 the following:
11	'6. Grandfathered signs. Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the
12 13	contrary, this section does not apply to a supplemental guide sign that was lawfully
13 14 15	installed prior to July 1, 2014. The signing agency may change the location of a supplemental guide sign that was lawfully installed prior to July 1, 2014 to a location that is closer to the destination displayed on the supplemental guide sign.'
16	SUMMARY
17	This amendment exempts from the provisions of the bill those supplemental guide
18	signs that were lawfully installed prior to July 1, 2014. In addition, this amendment
19	authorizes the Maine Turnpike Authority or the Department of Transportation, as
20	appropriate, to change the location of a supplemental guide sign that was lawfully
21 22	installed prior to July 1, 2014 to a location that is closer to the destination displayed on
22	the supplemental guide sign
