Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment eliminates the General Fund appropriation of \$25,133 in fiscal year 2014-15 to the Bureau of Labor Standards within the Department of Labor. The department has indicated that the legislation will not require the oversight or enforcement services of the bureau.
