The Department of Education and the Education Research Institute shall submit their preliminary findings and recommendations to the commission no later than November 1, 2014; and be it further'

32 SUMMARY

This amendment makes the following changes to the resolve:

It provides that the commission is required to consider certain agenda items related to the work plan and timeline for the review of certain cost components that the commission is required to address during meetings to be scheduled in July, October, November and December 2014 prior to the commission submitting its final report to the
