COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 108, L.D. 294, Bill, "An Act To Allow a Home Heating Oil Delivery Driver To Bleed a Home Heating Oil Burner"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §18134-A in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "of" the following: "a residential home"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §18134-A in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "home heating oil burner without direct supervision" and inserting the following: 'residential home heating oil burner without direct supervision if the delivery driver has documentation of having completed a board-approved training course in bleeding oil burners'

SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the committee. It provides that a home heating oil delivery driver may bleed a residential home heating oil burner without direct supervision if the driver has documentation of completion of a training course in bleeding oil burners approved by the Maine Fuel Board.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Allowing a home heating oil delivery driver to bleed a home heating oil burner without obtaining an apprentice oil burner license may reduce the amount of licensing fee revenue collected by the Maine Fuel Board within the Office of Professional and Occupational Regulation, Department of Professional and Financial Regulation. The decrease in dedicated revenue is expected to be minor.
