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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 136, L.D. 368, Bill, "An Act To Integrate the State's General Assistance and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families Programs"

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Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 3 in the last line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "subsection 18" the following: 'except that a person who has applied for an extension of benefits under that section but with respect to whom the process is not yet complete may be considered eligible'

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Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

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'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
