1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11251, sub-§2** is enacted to read:

3 **2. Youth day.** The commissioner shall establish by rule a youth hunting day for
4 hunting bear from 30 minutes before sunrise to 30 minutes after sunset. The day must be
5 the Saturday prior to the opening of the open season for hunting bear under subsection 1.
6 Rules adopted under this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5,
7 chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

8 **SUMMARY**

9 This bill requires the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to establish by
10 rule a youth bear hunting day on the Saturday prior to the opening of bear hunting season.
