2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§96 is enacted to read:
3	96. American Legion and Veterans of Foreign Wars. Sales to posts of the
4	American Legion or Veterans of Foreign Wars.
5	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect October 1, 2015.
6	SUMMARY
7	This bill provides an exemption from the sales and use tax for sales made to posts of
8	the American Legion or Veterans of Foreign Wars.
