1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1490, sub-§2, ¶D is enacted to read:
3	D. Notwithstanding paragraph C, bonds issued by a regional school unit may be
4	repaid using a level debt payment structure. For purposes of this paragraph, "level
5	debt payment structure" means a debt service structure in which the combined annual
6	principal and interest payments remain approximately the same throughout the life of
7	the issue of the bonds with increasing principal amounts and decreasing interest
8	amounts each year.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill authorizes a regional school unit to issue bonds that may be repaid using a
11	level debt payment structure.
