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

### Fiscal Note

State Mandate - Exempted

#### State Mandates

Required Activity	Unit Affected	Local Cost
Requires municipal clerks to file determinations of abandonment with the registry of deeds.	Municipality	Insignificant statewide

Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional costs.
