2 costs are strictly limited to expenditures for expert witness fees, copying of documents
3 and transcripts. Current law provides that when, pursuant to a court order or settlement,
4 the Attorney General receives money that is specifically designated for antitrust
5 enforcement or for enforcement of the Maine Unfair Trade Practices Act, the Attorney
6 General is authorized to expend these funds for expert witness fees, copying of
7 documents and transcripts and any other purpose in accordance with the court order.
