Cost-of-living Adjustment to Private Nonmedical Institutions and
Adult Family Care Homes**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Annual cost-of-living adjustment.** The Department of Health and
3 Human Services shall amend its rules in Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual,
4 Chapter III, Section 2, Adult Family Care Services and Chapter III, Section 97, Appendix
5 C: Principles of Reimbursement for Medical and Remedial Service Facilities and in the
6 department's Chapter 115: Principles of Reimbursement for Residential Care Facilities -
7 Room and Board Costs to provide for ongoing, annual rate changes beginning July 1,
8 2016 to adjust for inflation. For the state fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the amount of
9 the adjustment is 4%. For each year thereafter, the department shall set the inflation
10 adjustment cost-of-living percentage change in reimbursement in accordance with the
11 United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index
12 medical care services index.

13 **Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and
14 allocations are made.

28 **SUMMARY**

29 This bill provides funds to give adult family care homes, residential care facilities and
 30 Appendix C private nonmedical institutions a 4% cost-of-living rate increase in funding
 31 in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016. Annual cost-of-living adjustments are to be
 32 provided by rule for each fiscal year thereafter in accordance with the United States
 33 Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index medical care
 34 services index.
