1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §8701, sub-§7, as enacted by PL 2013, c. 543, §1, is repealed.
3	SUMMARY
4	Current law prohibits a person from making a bad faith assertion of patent
5	infringement against another person. A person who does make a bad faith assertion may
6	have to pay remedies awarded by the court, including equitable relief, damages, costs and
7	fees and punitive damages; however, the law exempts persons seeking relief pursuant to
8	35 United States Code, Section 271(e)(2) or 42 United States Code, Section 262 from the
9	law prohibiting bad faith assertions of patent infringement, which may include businesses
10	such as pharmaceutical companies. This bill removes the exemption.
