1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§101 is enacted to read:
3 4	101. Parent-teacher organizations. Sales to a parent-teacher organization organized as a public benefit corporation as described in Title 13-B, section 1406.
5	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect October 1, 2017.

7 8	This bill provides a sales tax exemption to parent-teacher organizations organized as public benefit corporations.
