The Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court may shall establish a veterans treatment courts court for veterans and members of the United States Armed Forces in Androscoggin County and may establish additional veterans treatment courts for veterans and members of the United States Armed Forces. The Supreme Judicial Court may adopt administrative orders and court rules of practice and procedure as necessary.
