2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6747-A is enacted to read:
3	§6747-A. Limits in Washington County
4	A person may not drag for mussels in any river in Washington County.
5	Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §6773 is enacted to read:
6	§6773. Marine worm harvesting season
7 8	A person may not fish for or take marine worms from December 1st through March 31st.
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12	This bill prohibits dragging for mussels in any river in Washington County. The bill also establishes a closed season for marine worms from December 1st through March 31st.
