24 25 26 27 28 29	In addition to the bill's requirements that an operator of a motorcycle or moped and a passenger under 18 years of age must wear protective headgear, this amendment provides that an operator of a moped operating under a learner's permit or within one year of successfully completing a driving test must wear protective headgear. The amendment also provides that the operator of a moped may not allow a passenger under 18 years of age to ride without protective headgear.
