Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1483, sub-§12, as amended by PL 2009, c. 434, §20, is further amended to read:
12. Certain veterans. Automobiles owned by veterans who are granted free registration of those vehicles by the Secretary of State under Title 29-A, section 523 subsection 1 and automobiles owned by veterans who have been diagnosed with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis;
SUMMARY
This bill exempts from excise tax an automobile owned by a veteran who has been diagnosed with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis.
