18	1. A person is guilty of aggravated sex trafficking if the person knowingly:
19 20	A. Promotes prostitution by compelling a person to enter into, engage in or remain in prostitution. Violation of this paragraph is a Class B crime;
21 22 23	B. Promotes prostitution of a person less than 18 years old by compelling that person to enter into, engage in or remain in prostitution. Violation of this paragraph is a Class A crime; or

Promotes prostitution of a person who suffers from a mental disability that is reasonably apparent or known to the actor and that in fact renders the other person substantially incapable of appraising the nature of the conduct involved. <u>Violation of this paragraph is a Class B crime</u> .

4	SUMMARY
5	This amendment is the majority report of the committee. The amendment replaces
6	the bill and changes the title to read, An Act Regarding the Penalties for Sex Trafficking
7	and Aggravated Sex Trafficking. The amendment increases the penalty for the crime of
8	sex trafficking if the person who is trafficked is less than 18 years of age to a Class C
9	crime. The amendment increases the penalty for the crime of aggravated sex trafficking
10	if the person who is trafficked is less than 18 years of age from a Class B crime to a Class
11	A crime if the actor compels the minor to enter into, engage in or remain in prostitution.
