2	Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §7482, first \P , as amended by PL 2009, c. 428, §1, is further amended to read:
4 5 6 7	Notwithstanding the total amount of a debt or contract, a "small claim" means a right of action cognizable by a court if the debt or damage does not exceed \$6,000 \$15,000 exclusive of interest and costs. It does not include an action involving the title to real estate.
3	SUMMARY
9	This bill increases the jurisdictional limits for small claims from \$6,000 to \$15,000.
