Rules limiting taking of smelts from coastal waters prohibited; 2 study. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Marine Resources may not adopt or 3 enforce rules that limit the quantity of smelts a person may take from the coastal waters 4 of the State before a study of the smelt population in the State's coastal waters is 5 conducted by the Department of Marine Resources and presented to the joint standing 6 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources matters.

## **SUMMARY**

8 This resolve prohibits the Commissioner of Marine Resources from adopting or 9 enforcing a limit on the quantity of smelts a person may take from the coastal waters 10 before the Department of Marine Resources conducts a study of the smelt population in 11 the State's coastal waters and presents its findings to the joint standing committee of the 12 Legislature having jurisdiction over marine resources matters.
