COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

SUMMARY

The amendment replaces the bill. Like the bill, the amendment prohibits the State from including questions about criminal history on its employment application forms. The amendment provides an exception to that prohibition when, due to the nature and requirements of the position, a person who has a criminal history record may be disqualified from eligibility, such as for a law enforcement officer, corrections officer, child protective and adult protective services caseworker or child development services worker. The amendment applies to state employment positions in the legislative, executive or judicial branches of State Government and positions with quasi-independent state entities or public instrumentalities of the State; it does not apply to positions in school administrative units, municipalities, counties or other political subdivisions of the State.

This amendment also provides funding to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services for computer modifications made necessary by the amendment.
