1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 **CONCEPT DRAFT SUMMARY** 3 4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208. This bill proposes to amend current law to authorize the Secretary of State to administer recounts in an efficient and effective manner, to increase the number of voter 5 6 signatures required for a statewide recount, to lower the threshold for a free statewide 7 recount and to authorize the Secretary of State to develop by rule processes for 8 9 multicounty and statewide recounts.
