1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15697, as enacted by IB 2015, c. 4, §1, is repealed.
3	Sec. 2. 36 MRSA §5111, sub-§6, as enacted by IB 2015, c. 4, §2, is repealed.
4	SUMMARY
5	This bill repeals the provisions establishing the Fund to Advance Public Kindergarten
6	to Grade 12 Education and the income tax surcharge of 3% imposed on taxable income of
7	\$200,000 or more, which is the source of revenue for the fund
