12 13	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting the following:
14	'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §11209-A is enacted to read:
15	§11209-A. Discharge of firearm within 300 feet of state-owned boat launching ramp
16 17	1. Prohibition. A person may not discharge a firearm within 300 feet of a state-owned boat launching ramp that is posted in accordance with subsection 2.
18 19 20	2. Posting. An agency of the State having jurisdiction over a state-owned boat launching ramp may post notice, in a prominent location at the boat launching ramp, that the discharge of a firearm is prohibited within 300 feet of the boat launching ramp.
21 22	3. Exception. This section does not apply to a law enforcement officer in the performance of the law enforcement officer's official duties.
23	4. Penalty. A person who violates subsection 1 commits a Class E crime.'
24	SUMMARY
25 26 27 28 29 30	This amendment replaces the bill and provides that an agency of the State having jurisdiction over a state-owned boat launching ramp may post notice, in a prominent location at the boat launching ramp, that the discharge of a firearm is prohibited within 300 feet of the boat launching ramp. A person who discharges a firearm within 300 feet of a boat launching ramp that is posted in accordance with this provision commits a Class E crime.
