1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2014 is enacted to read:
3	<u>§2014. Sale of firearm to include gun lock</u>
4 5	1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.
6	A. "Firearm" has the same meaning as in Title 17-A, section 2, subsection 12-A.
7 8 9	B. "Firearm dealer" means a person who is licensed as a dealer under 18 United States Code, Section 923, or who is required to be licensed as a dealer under that section.
10 11 12 13	C. "Gun lock" means a device external to a firearm or part of a firearm that prevents the firearm from discharging until the device is removed or deactivated and is approved by a firearm safety device laboratory recognized by the California Department of Justice.
14 15	2. Requirement. A firearm dealer may not sell at retail a firearm without also selling the purchaser a gun lock for that firearm.
16	SUMMARY
17 18	This bill requires a firearm dealer to sell a gun lock with every firearm the dealer sells at retail in the State.
