2	Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §423, sub-§5 is enacted to read:
3 4	5. Penalty. Notwithstanding section 349, a person who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a fine of not less than \$1,000 may be adjudged.
5	SUMMARY
6 7 8 9	This bill establishes a penalty of not less than \$1,000 for the discharge of waste from watercraft in inland waters or for operating on inland waters a watercraft that has a permanently installed sanitary waste disposal system if it does not have a holding tank to prevent the discharge of sanitary waste into inland waters.
