4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5 6 7 8	This bill proposes to require MaineCare to cover mental health treatment for a child that uses evidence-based practices, to include meetings with the parent of the child without the child present as long as the meetings are focused on the goals of the treatment.
