1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 **CONCEPT DRAFT SUMMARY** 3 4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208. 5 This bill proposes to enact measures designed to ensure that schools are authorized and encouraged to consider courses taken by a student in computer science as 6 demonstrating proficiency in science or mathematics, or both. Under this bill, the value 7 of computer science coursework would be recognized as part of a student's path to 8 9 proficiency.
