The department shall compute the statewide average rate per MaineCare member day based on the simple average of the nursing facility rate per MaineCare member day for the applicable state fiscal year or years prorated for the hospital's fiscal year. Reimbursement for days awaiting placement pursuant to this section is limited to a maximum of \$500,000 of combined General Fund funds and federal funds for each year. For purposes of this section, "critical access hospital" has the same meaning as in section 7932, subsection 10.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment eliminates the General Fund appropriation to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$17,690 in fiscal year 2017-18 and reduces the appropriation by \$17,700 in fiscal year 2018-19 to delay the reimbursement to hospitals other than critical access hospitals for each day after the 10th day that a MaineCare-eligible individual is in the care of a hospital while awaiting placement in a nursing facility, until January 1, 2019. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also reduced for the FMAP match.
