2	Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §150-N is enacted to read:
3	§150-N. Maine Community Litter Cleanup Day
4 5 6	The first Saturday in May is designated Maine Community Litter Cleanup Day, and the Governor shall annually issue a proclamation inviting and urging the citizens of the State to observe this day through appropriate activities such as removing litter from roads.

8 9	This bill establishes the first Saturday in May as Maine Community Litter Cleanup Day.
