Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to convene working 17 18 group. Resolved: That the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall convene 19 a working group of interested stakeholders to study, assess and evaluate salmonid fish 20 culture facilities in the State and the associated production and distribution capabilities, 21 opportunities, needs and contributions to the economy of the State of cultured salmonid fish and propose changes to the fish production laws and rules based on its findings; and 22 23 be it further 24 Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That, by December 6, 2017, the Department of Inland 25 Fisheries and Wildlife shall submit a report on the working group's proposed changes 26 under section 1 to the Joint Standing Committee on Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The 27 joint standing committee may report out a bill concerning the report to the Second 28 Regular Session of the 128th Legislature.' 29 SUMMARY 30 This amendment is a minority report of the committee. It replaces the resolve and 31 requires the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to convene a working group to 32 study, assess and evaluate salmonid fish culture facilities in the State and the associated 33 production and distribution capabilities, opportunities, needs and contributions to the 34 economy of the State of cultured salmonid fish and propose changes to the fish
