1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17904, sub-§3 is enacted to read:
3 4	3. Qualification of a disabled veteran. A member who is a disabled veteran who has been awarded a disability pension under 38 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 3.3
5 6 7	(2003) for a service-connected disability qualifies for a disability retirement benefit under this article. This subsection applies to all applications for disability retirement benefits filed on or after January 1, 2018.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill provides that a veteran who is a member of the Maine Public Employees
10	Retirement System and who has been awarded a disability pension under 38 Code of
11	Federal Regulations, Section 3.3 (2003) for a service-connected disability is qualified for
12	disability retirement benefits under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 423,
13	article 3. The provisions of the bill apply to all applications for disability retirement
14	benefits filed on or after January 1, 2018.
