The 17 increase in the State's total cost for retired teachers' health insurance premiums for fiscal 18 years ending after June 30, 2015 is budgeted at no more than any percentage increase in 19 the Consumer Price Index as defined in Title 5, section 17001, subsection 9 plus 3%. A 20 provider of a health insurance benefit plan for retired teachers must make available data 21 related to the provider's premium costs and any related data as requested by the Executive 22 Director of Health Insurance within the Department of Administrative and Financial 23 Services.' 24 **SUMMARY** 25 This amendment removes the language that caps the increase in the State's total cost 26 for retired teachers' health insurance premiums for certain fiscal years.
