17 18	Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 7-B in the 4th line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: " <u>hunting</u> " the following: ' <u>or fishing</u> '
19	SUMMARY
20 21 22 23	The bill prohibits destroying, tearing down, defacing or otherwise damaging property posting signs by hunters and provides for the one-year suspension of the hunting license of a person who is convicted of doing so. This amendment provides for a one-year suspension of the person's fishing license as well.

The Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife may incur minor costs to revoke hunting and fishing licenses of those convicted of damaging property posting signs. Requiring violators ineligible to obtain a hunting or fishing license for a period of one year may reduce the number of licenses issued and reduce General Fund revenue by a
