1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §600-A is enacted to read:

3 <u>§600-A. Prospective employees' social security numbers</u>

An employer may not request a social security number from a prospective employee on an employment application or during the application process for employment. This section does not apply to intake of prospective employee information for the purposes of substance abuse testing under subchapter 3-A or a preemployment background check or to information required for tax withholding and other necessary purposes after the employee is hired.

SUMMARY

11 This bill prohibits an employer from requesting a social security number from a 12 prospective employee on an employment application or during the application process for 13 employment. This bill does not apply to the intake of information for substance abuse 14 testing or a preemployment background check or after the employee is hired as required 15 for tax withholding and other necessary purposes.
