Sec. 1. Maine Board of Pharmacy to convene work group. Resolved: That the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Maine Board of Pharmacy shall convene a work group to propose updates to the Maine Pharmacy Act and any laws associated with the provisions of that Act. The work group must include 2 members of the Maine Board of Pharmacy, including the administrator of the board; one member representing a college of pharmacy in the State; one member representing the American Society of Hospital Pharmacists; one member representing the Maine Pharmacy Association; and stakeholders representing the pharmaceutical industry, wholesale pharmacies, retail pharmacies and hospital pharmacies; and be it further

**Sec. 2. Report. Resolved:** That, by December 15, 2017, the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Maine Board of Pharmacy shall submit a report on the work group's recommended legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Labor, Commerce, Research and Economic Development. The joint standing committee may report out a bill concerning the report to the Second Regular Session of the 128th Legislature.

16 SUMMARY

This bill requires the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Maine Board of Pharmacy to convene a work group to propose updates to the Maine Pharmacy Act and submit a report to the Joint Standing Committee on Labor, Commerce, Research and Economic Development. The joint standing committee may report out a bill concerning the report to the Second Regular Session of the 128th Legislature.
