1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 9-A MRSA §8-509, as enacted by PL 2011, c. 427, Pt. A, §15, is repealed.
3	SUMMARY
4	Current law prohibits the seller in a sales transaction from imposing a surcharge on a
5	cardholder who pays using a credit card or debit card. This bill repeals that prohibition.

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
